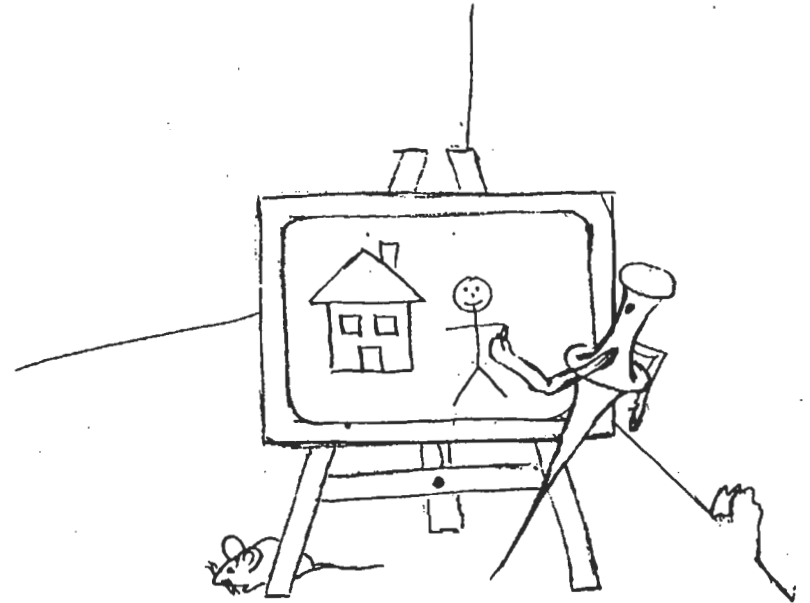
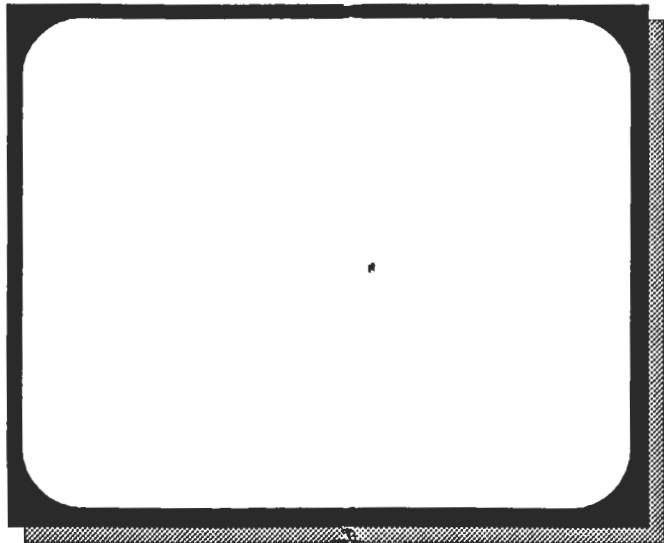

is a pin which does drawings.

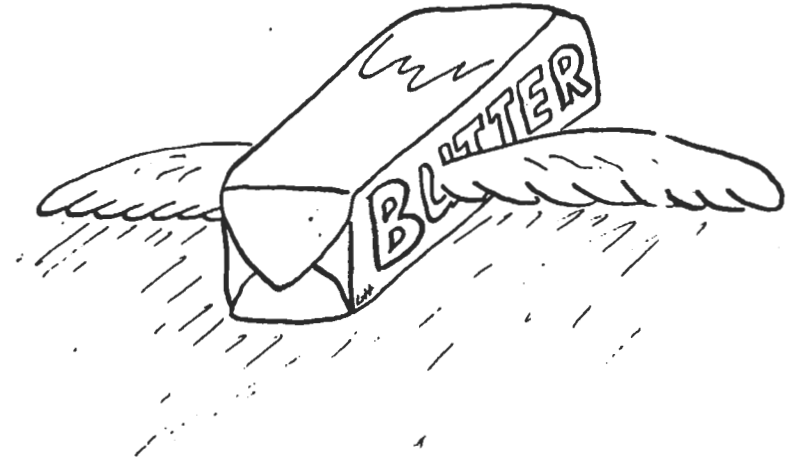
Can you do a drawing too?

What do you like to eat?

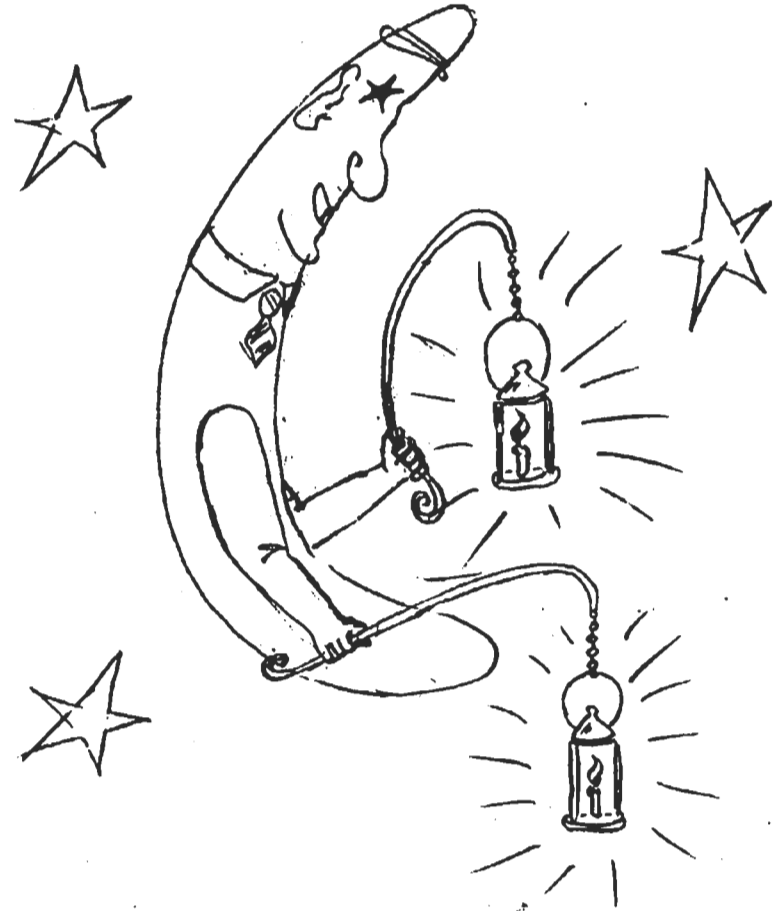


The Moonlight

outside at night?

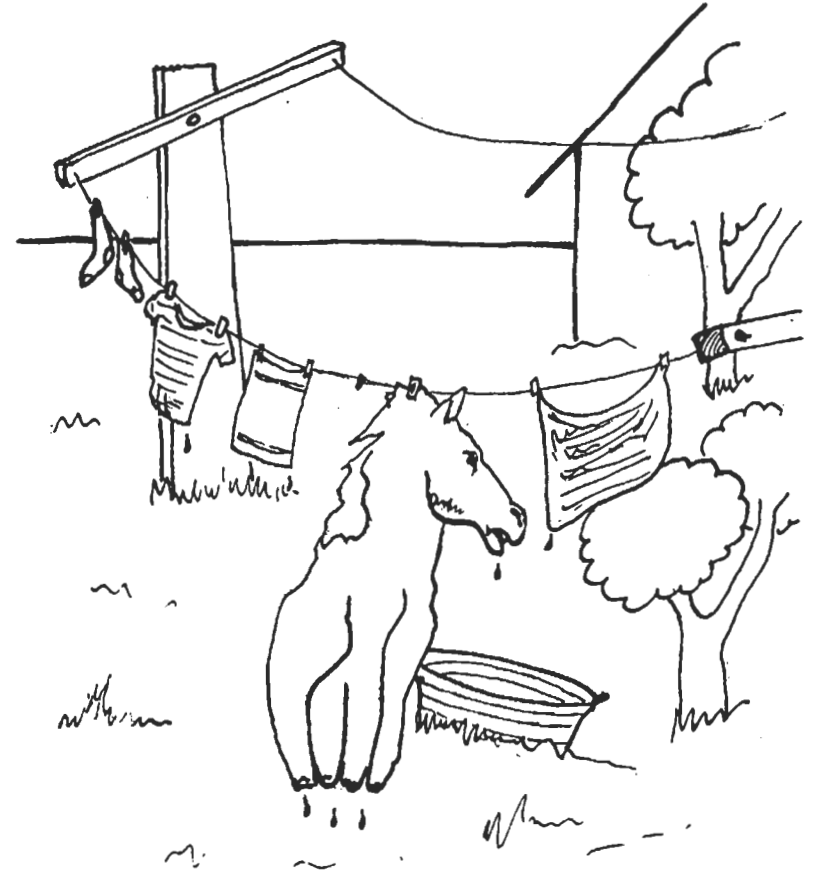


The Clothes Horse

What games do you like to play?

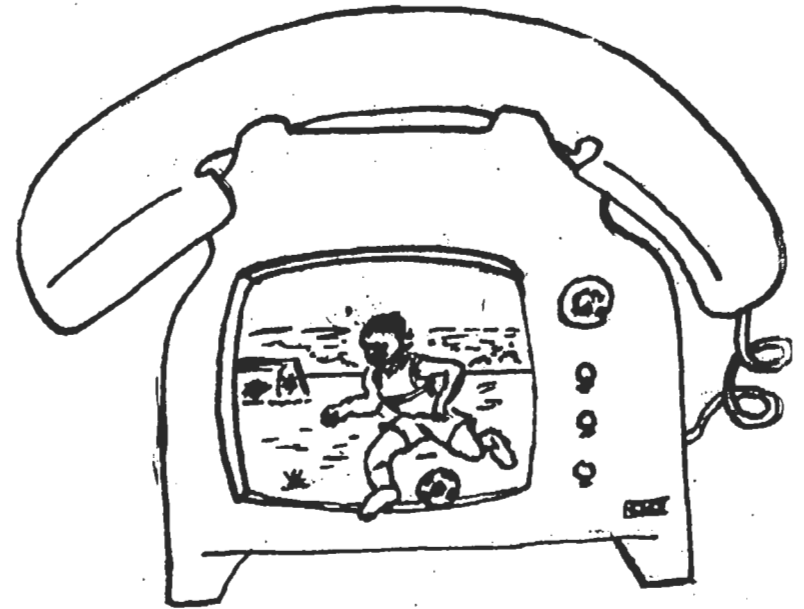


The Telephone

What do you watch on television?

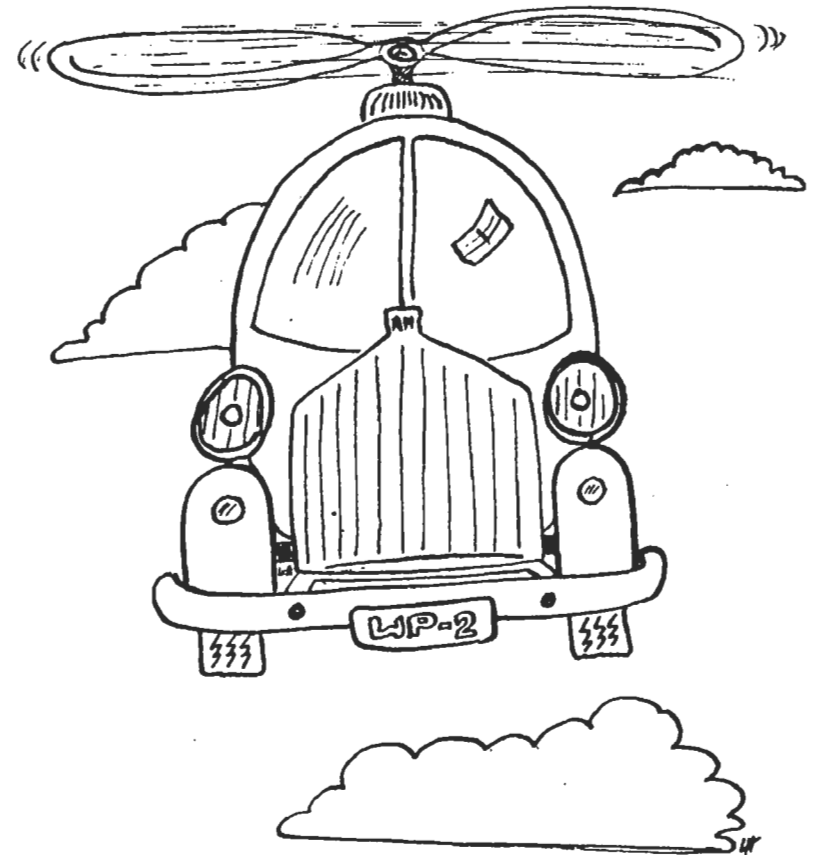
Count up how much time

such a thing as a **rolls hoist**.

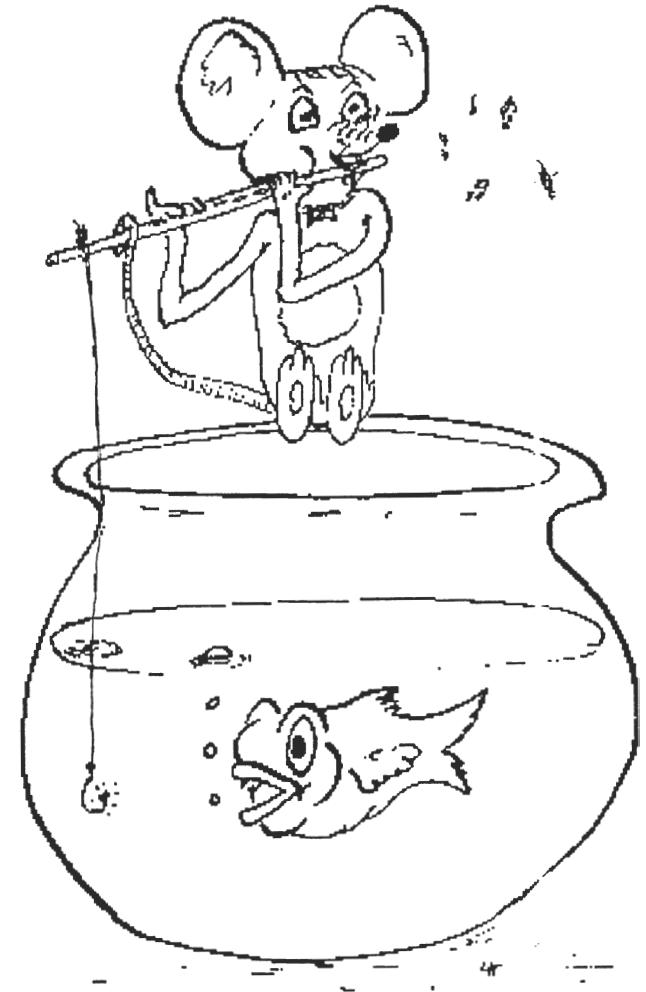
Where is it going?

a bare behind.

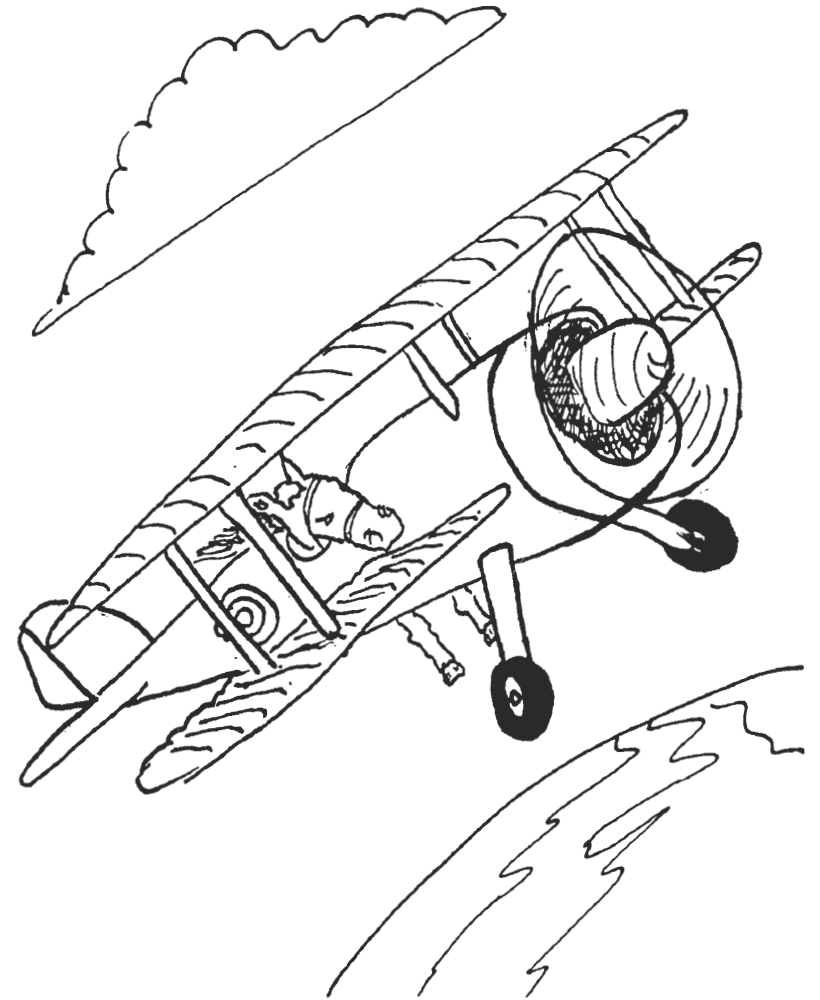
What do you think the bear

The Monkeys

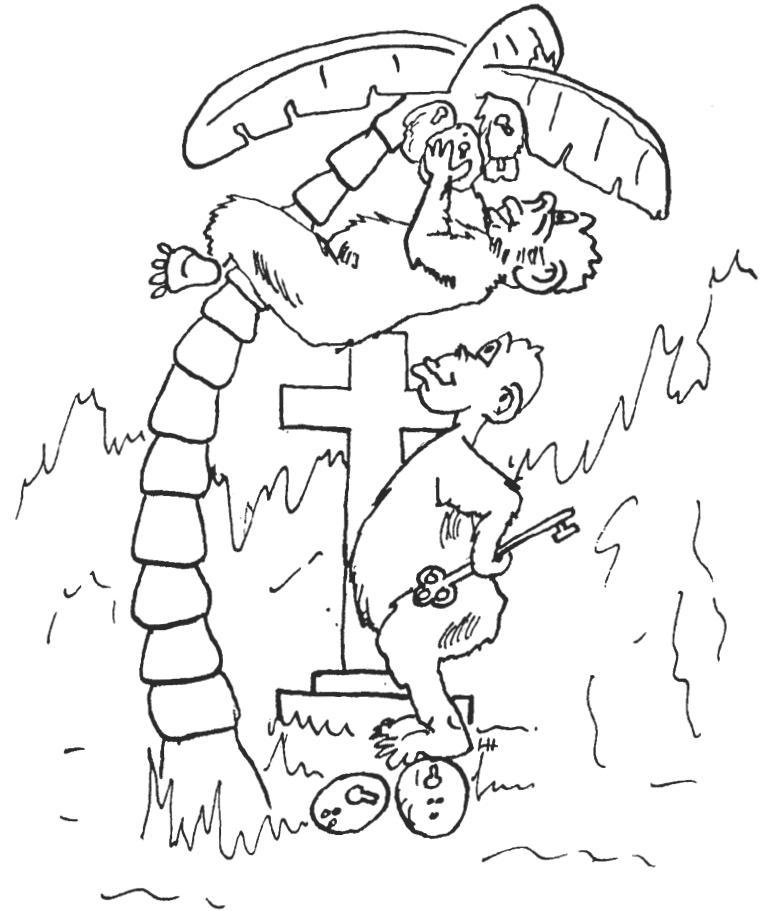
Are coconuts found in monasteries?

Does a monk use keys?

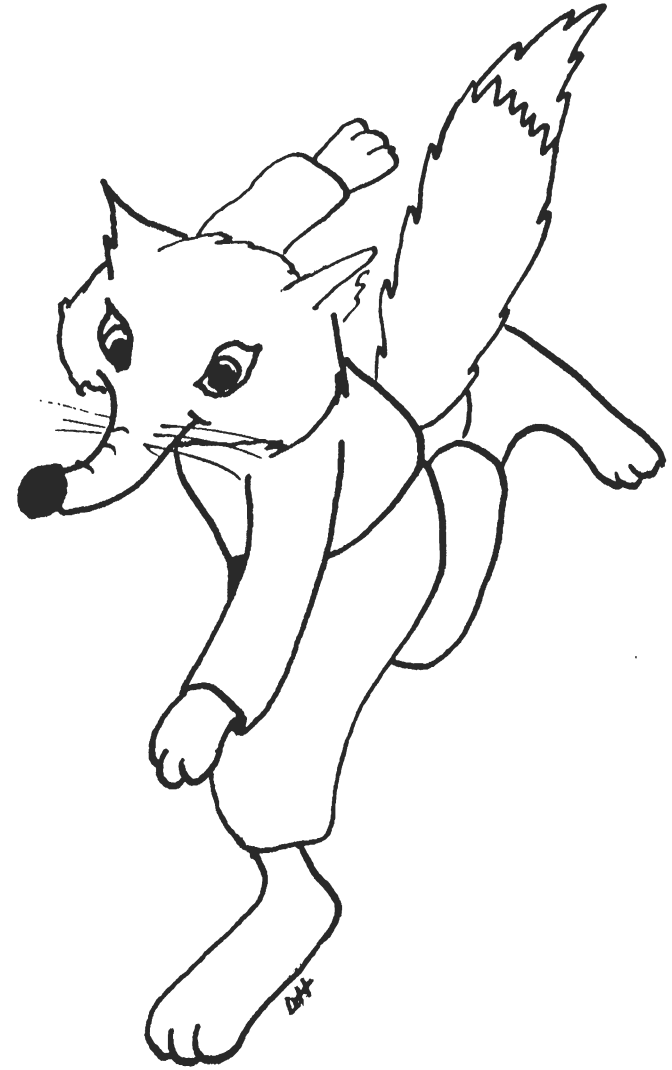
What do you think monkeys eat?
